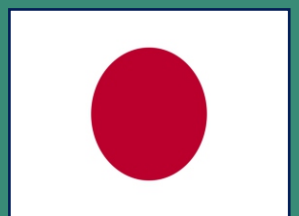
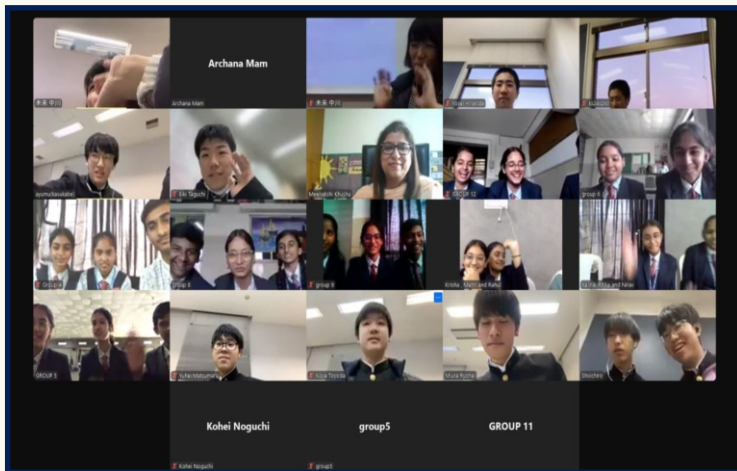
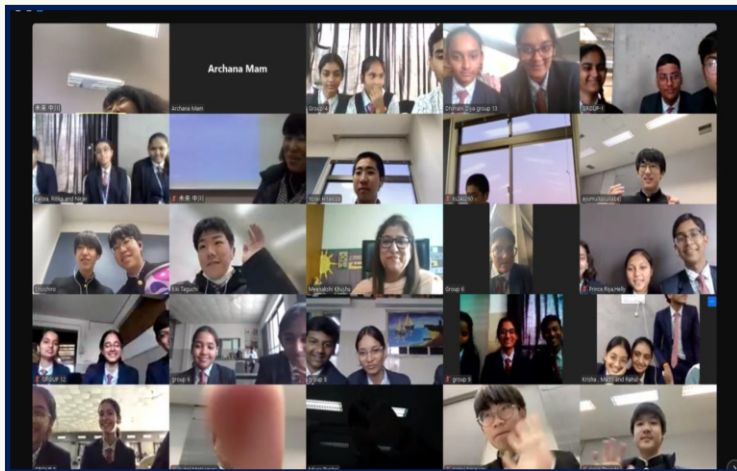
EMBRACING THE WORLD | A STEP TOWARD GLOBAL CITIZENSHIP

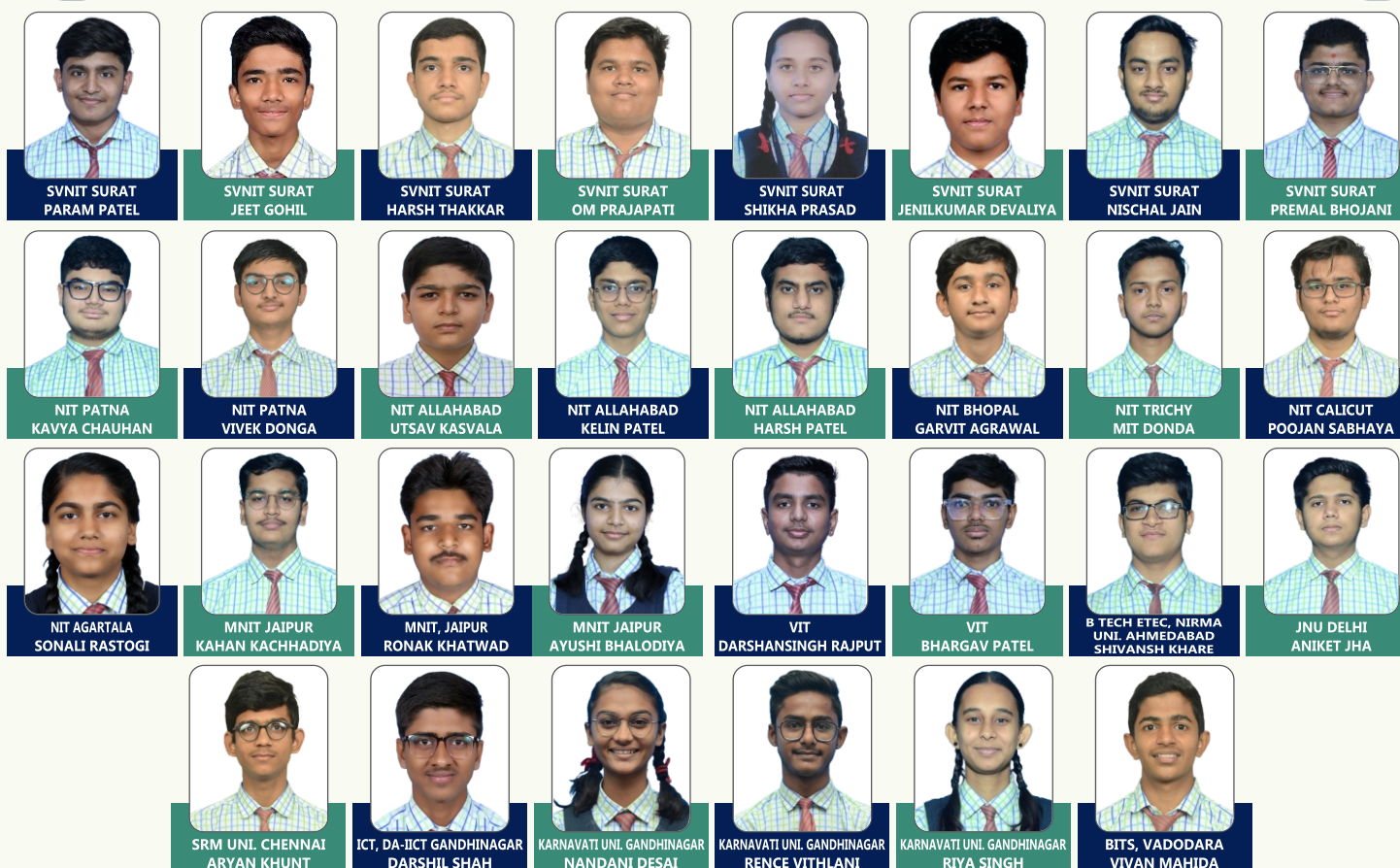

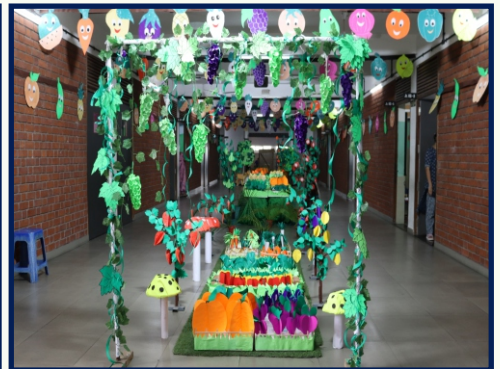
BLUE DAY

MORNING ASSEMBLIES - FOCUS ON WELL-BEING AND VALUES

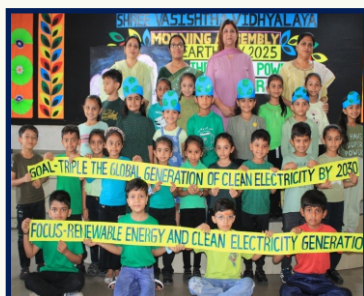
Throughout the year, our morning assemblies were dedicated to themes promoting strong morals, good etiquette, and essential wellbeing.

BUILDING SKILLS THROUGH EXPERIENCES

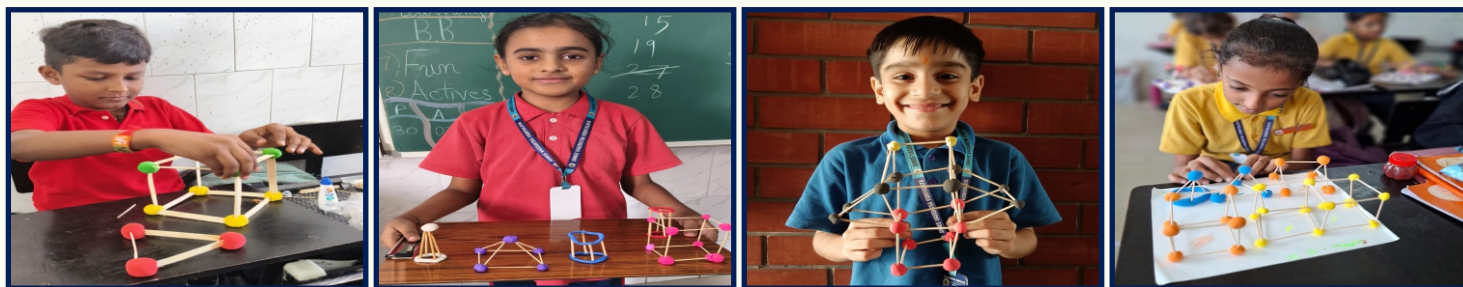
FLOWER & BASKET MAKING ACTIVITY

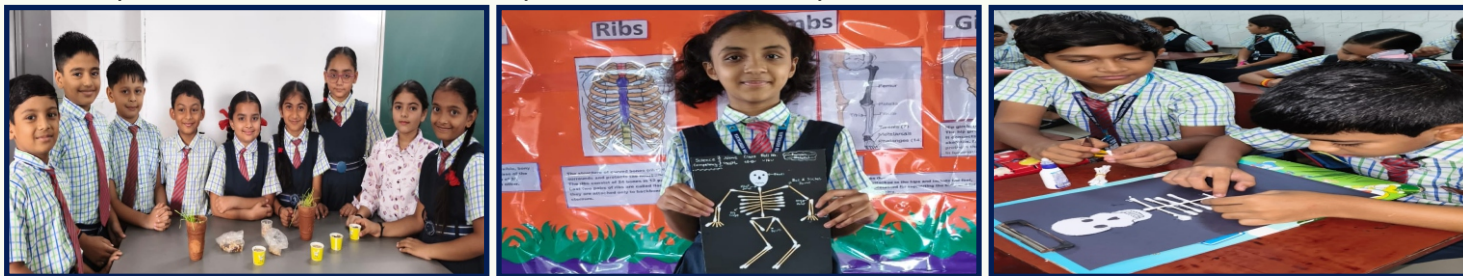
MATHS MODEL MAKING

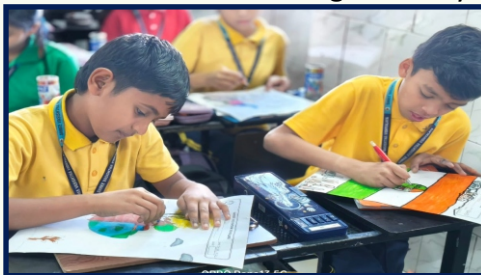
DRAWING AND COLOURING ACTIVITY

WORKSHOP ON UNDERSTANDING LEARNERS: HOW CHILDREN LEARN?

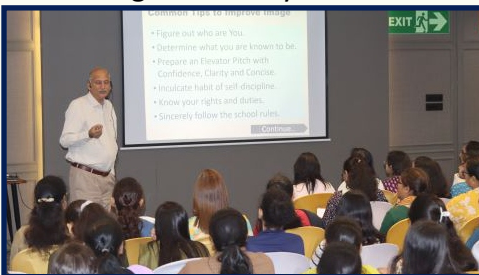

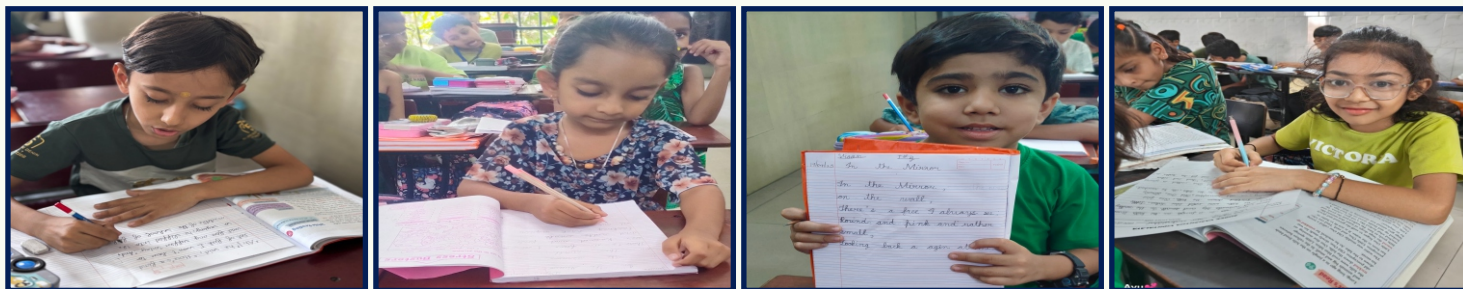


CELEBRATING TALENT THROUGH INTER-HOUSE COMPETITIONS
